Thank you very much for your recent enquiry, and for your interest in the Namibia Evangelical Theological Seminary (NETS). I enclose an Application Packet which includes an Application Form, our prospectus, a schedule of Tuition and Fees (small bursaries may be available as funds allow), and a letter for your pastor with a form for him/her to complete and return to NETS. Further details of any of the programmes are available on request.

To apply for any of the programmes, please complete and return the enclosed Application Form. To enable us to process your application efficiently, please take care to complete all sections on the form including the check list on the last page. This checklist details a number of documents which must be included in your application.

You will normally be expected to be present for an interview with the Admissions Committee before you begin your studies. Each new academic year begins toward the end of January. All documents must be available at NETS at that interview. The semester dates for all programmes for the next academic year will be available from September of the prior year.

#### **For non-Namibian applicants**

If you are a non-Namibian applicant, you will need a study permit to study at NETS from the Namibian Ministry of Home Affairs. We can assist you with this application once you have been successfully admitted as a student to NETS. Alternative arrangements for interviews may be made for you before you are admitted.

If you are a non-Namibian applicant, before you begin travel to NETS or enroll as a student, you must pay 100% of your first year's tuition fees or provide documented evidence (such as a current bank statement) that 100% of your annual fees for NETS are available to you.
